## SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

- Parents are legally responsible for getting their school-aged children to school regularly (article 226.1 of the Spanish Penal Code).
> Right to education.
> Protection of minors.

School absenteeism does not receive the attention it deserves in Spain

- PISA reports (25-28\% of school absences in the 4 th year of secondary compulsory.
- This socio-educational reality is scarcely visible.

## School absenteeism

- Unjustified absence from the classroom of a student of compulsory school age from 6 to 16 years old (Cruz et al., 2017).

- Mild absenteeism: $15 \%$ to $25 \%$ of unjustified absences.
- Serious absenteeism: $25 \%$ to $50 \%$ of unjustified absences.
