






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Distribution of schools in public, private and semi-private schools (2021-2022)

The **Organic Law 30/2020** by which is modify The Organic Law 2/2006 and abolish the Organic Law 8/2013.




#### SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

  - > Protection of minors.


# School absenteeism does not receive the attention it deserves in Spain

- PISA reports (25-28% of school absences in the 4th year of secondary compulsory.
- This socio-educational reality is scarcely visible.

#### School absenteeism

 Unjustified absence from the classroom of a student of compulsory school age from 6 to 16 years old (Cruz et al., 2017).

- Mild absenteeism: 15% to 25% of unjustified absences.
- Serious absenteeism: 25% to 50% of unjustified absences.


- ☐ Data and figures School year 2021-2022: early school leaving.

- ☐ Invisibility and lack of public presence.
- Between 5 and 10% the percentage of students of school age affected by school absenteeism (Barcelona).





#### Strengths and weaknesses



- \* The state and regional regulations for the protection of minors highlight the right to education.
  - \* Action protocols to combat school absenteeism.
    - \* Specialized research groups.
